Monitoring and Reporting

The UW School of Environmental and Forest Sciences tracks and monitors a number of aspects of our academic programs to ensure that we are achieving success or improving on our numeric and diversity goals within our programs. The following data are collected and reported for these purposes.

Data on Each Graduate Admissions Cycle

At the conclusion of each graduate admissions cycle (currently May 1) SEFS gathers statistical data on gender and ethnicity from: 1. the applicant pool; 2. the admitted applicant pool; and 3. the admitted and offer accepted applicant pool.

These data will be broken down into two sets: as a percentage of each of the total pool, by male/female/nonbinary; and by self-identified ethnicity and international status. The resulting information will be presented to the faculty in a faculty meeting, and maintained and tracked over time to identify trends and consider corrections that can be made by our recruitment and admissions processes.
